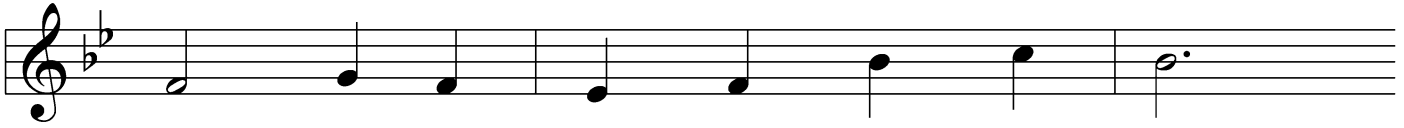


Creator Spirit, Heavenly Dove

Attributed to Rhabanus Maurus, 776-856

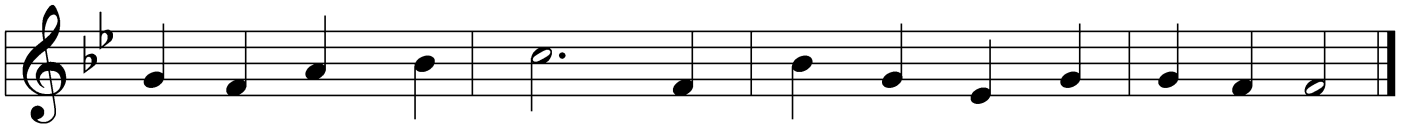
