HEIDELBERG CATECHISM

Q. 54. What do you believe concerning the holy catholic Christian church?

I believe that the Son of God,^[1] out of the whole human race,^[2] from the beginning of the world to its end,^[3] gathers, defends, and preserves for Himself,^[4] by his Spirit and Word,^[5] in the unity of the true faith,^[6] a church chosen to everlasting life.^[7] And I believe that I am^[8] and forever shall remain a living member of it.^[9]
