



Redeemer Choir - Job Description

Purpose

As a member of the Redeemer Choir, you play a vital role in leading our congregation in their spoken and sung responses in the weekly Divine Services. The ensemble is ideally situated in the back of the sanctuary and, with the organ, provides strong support for the people in their worship of God.

Duties

- Attend weekly choir rehearsals on Wednesday at 7 pm. The annual rehearsal schedule runs from mid-August to June.
- Attend the Sunday morning rehearsals at 8 am and sing in both morning services at 8:45 and 11:15 am.
- Attend the feast day rehearsals and services:
 1. Christmas Eve
 2. Epiphany (January 6)
 3. Ash Wednesday
 4. Good Friday
 5. Ascension Day
- Attend choir dinners, hosted by members of the choir:
 1. September 19, 2025
 2. November 7, 2025
 3. January 23, 2026
 4. May 29, 2026

Who is a fit?

- We are seeking singers who love Jesus and desire to lead our congregation in worship.
- Though not absolutely required, it is important that you can read music.
- The singers need to become a part of the whole, seeking to unify their sound with that of the rest of the ensemble.

Commitment

- Attend all rehearsals for the year.
- Participate in all Sunday morning Divine Services: August 17, 2025, to June 21, 2026
- Participate in all feast day rehearsals and services (5)
- Participate in a Redeemer Choir concert on June 5 or 6, 2026, featuring choral arrangements of organ music by Felix Mendelssohn
