### ***Heidelberg Catechism***

**Q. 26. What do you believe when you say: I believe in God the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth?**

**A.** That the eternal Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who out of nothing created heaven and earth and all that is in them,<sup>[1]</sup> and who still upholds and governs them by his eternal counsel and providence,<sup>[2]</sup> is, for the sake of Christ his Son, my God and my Father.<sup>[3]</sup>

In him I trust so completely as to have no doubt that he will provide me with all things necessary for body and soul,<sup>[4]</sup> and will also turn to my good whatever adversity he sends me in this life of sorrow.<sup>[5]</sup>

He is able to do so as almighty God,<sup>[6]</sup> and willing also as a faithful Father.<sup>[7]</sup>
