



Redeemer Presbyterian Church Hospitality- Job Description

Purpose

As a Hospitality team member, you work behind the scenes to prepare coffee and food set up or tear down. Your role helps welcome congregants and guests with hospitality and encourages fellowship between services. Hospitality extends the welcome of the gospel through tangible service to others. In food and drink setup, you help extend the expectant welcome of the gospel. In tear down and clean up, you help assist the work of the church as a servant, assisting in meeting the tangible needs that go into the work of the church on the Lord's Day.

Duties

- If you are setting up, arrive at 8 AM to prepare coffee and drinks. Set up four tables in the courtyard. Layout food and drink on tables by 8:30 AM.
- Prepare coffee and other items. Follow the table setup guide and keep the table setup neat and orderly.
- If you are tearing down and cleaning up, at 12:45 PM, remove all items from 4 tables and wash tablecloths and beverage containers.

Who is a fit?

- Anyone who enjoys serving behind the scenes. If you enjoy the behind the scenes of hospitality preparation, this is a good role for you. Families and friend groups can serve together easily in this role.
- Someone who doesn't mind bringing tables in and out of the kitchen.

Commitment

- Serve either on setup and preparation or tear down and clean up one Sunday per month (12 times per year).
- If you are unable to be present on a Sunday, you are scheduled to give 24-hour notice whenever possible.
- Able to arrive by 8 AM or stay after second service.
