To teach us humility all this was done, To learn us from hence haughty pride for to shun. The manger his cradle who came from above, The great God of mercy, of peace and of love.




# THE WORDS OF OUR LORD



# **LESSONS**

#### Isaiah 62:10-12

Go through, go through the gates; prepare the way for the people; build up, build up the highway; clear it of stones; lift up a signal over the peoples.

Behold, the Lord has proclaimed to the end of the earth:

Say to the daughter of Zion, "Behold, your salvation comes; behold, his reward is with him, and his recompense before him."

And they shall be called The Holy People, The Redeemed of the Lord; and you shall be called Sought Out, A City Not Forsaken.

#### **Titus 3:4-7**
